“Take care of them until the fourteenth day of the month, when all the people of the community of Israel must slaughter them at twilight.”

Remembering God’s faithfulness: The Passover

Exodus 12:22-23 (NIV)

“Take a bunch of hyssop, dip it into the blood in the basin and put some of the blood on the top and on both sides of the doorframe.... When the LORD goes down through the land to strike down the Egyptians, he will see the blood on the top and sides of the doorframe and will pass over that doorway, and he will not permit the destroyer to enter your houses and strike you down.”

Exodus 12:8 (NIV)

“That same night they are to eat the meat roasted over the fire, along with bitter herbs, and bread made without yeast.”

Exodus 12:29-30 (NIV)

At midnight the LORD struck down all the firstborn in Egypt, from the firstborn of Pharaoh...to the firstborn of the prisoner....Pharaoh and all his officials and all the Egyptians got up during the night, and there was loud wailing in Egypt, for there was not a house without someone dead.

Remembering God’s faithfulness: The Passover

Exodus 12:31-33, 35-36 (NIV)

Pharaoh summoned Moses and Aaron and said, “Up! Leave my people, you and the Israelites! Go, worship the LORD as you have requested. Take your flocks and herds, as you have said, and go....”

The Egyptians urged the people to hurry and leave the country... The Israelites did as Moses instructed and asked the Egyptians for articles of silver and gold and for clothing. The LORD had made the Egyptians favorably disposed toward the people, and they gave them what they asked for....

Remembering God’s faithfulness: The Passover

Exodus 12:14, 25-27 (NIV)

“This is a day you are to commemorate; for the generations to come you shall celebrate it as a festival to the LORD - a lasting ordinance.”

“When you enter the land that the LORD will give you...observe this ceremony. And when your children ask you, ‘What does this ceremony mean to you?’ then tell them, ‘It is the Passover sacrifice to the LORD, who passed over the houses of the Israelites in Egypt and spared our homes when he struck down the Egyptians.’”

For you know it was not with perishable things such as silver or gold that you were redeemed from the empty way of life handed down to you from your forefathers, but with the precious blood of Christ, a lamb without blemish or defect.

Remembering God’s faithfulness: The Lord’s Supper

1 Corinthians 11:25-26 (NIV)

In the same way, after supper he took the cup, saying, “This cup is the new covenant in my blood; do this, whenever you drink it, in remembrance of me.” For whenever you eat this bread and drink this cup, you proclaim the Lord’s death until he comes.
