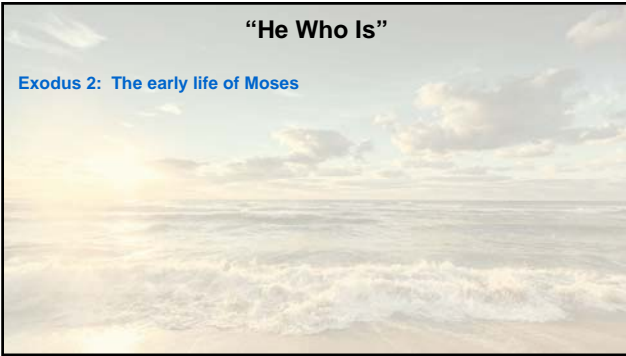

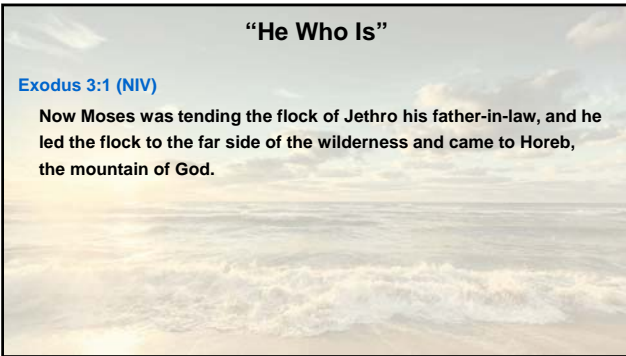
Exodus 2: The early life of Moses

Exodus 3:1 (NIV)

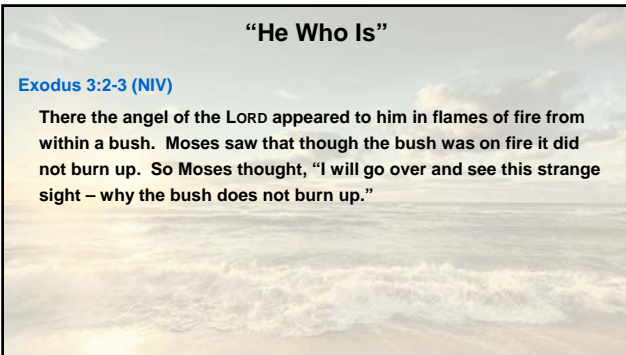
Now Moses was tending the flock of Jethro his father-in-law, and he led the flock to the far side of the wilderness and came to Horeb, the mountain of God.

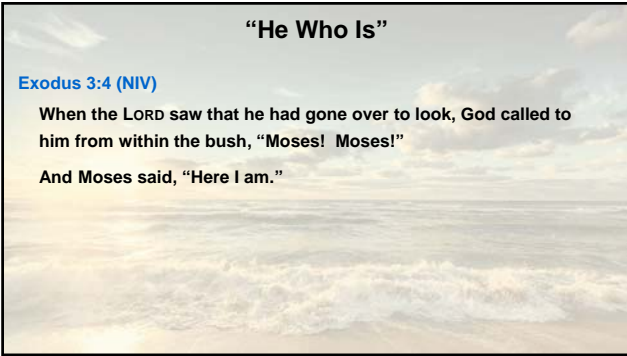


“He Who Is”

When the LORD saw that he had gone over to look, God called to him from within the bush, “Moses! Moses!”

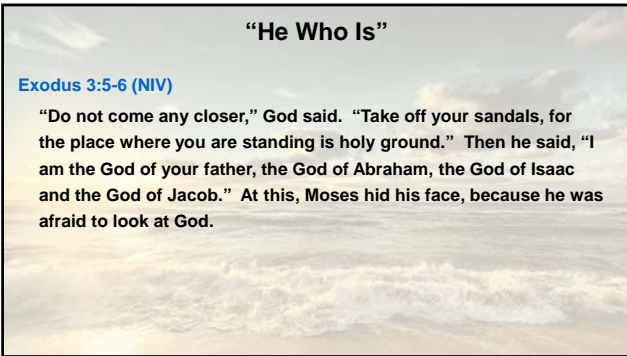
And Moses said, “Here I am.”

Exodus 3:5-6 (NIV)

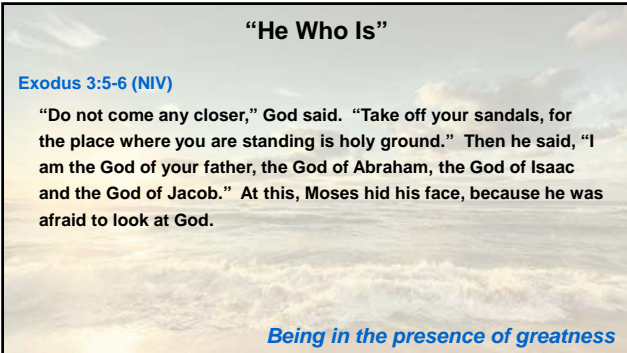

The LORD saves!


